
2024 National P&T Competition Phases

As members of the Clinical Pharmacy Services department at Patients First Health Plan, student teams are tasked with developing a formulary drug monograph for ZAVZPRETTM (zavegepant) and preparing a PowerPoint presentation to the P&T Committee.

All schools that choose to enter the 2024 National P&T Competition must upload the following assignments to the P&T Competition portal **no later than 11:59 pm EST** on Monday, January 22:


- Formulary drug monograph for Zavzpret, using the provided template.
- A file with supporting materials to include:
 - Completed individual study quality assessment questionnaires.
 - ICER Evidence Rating Matrix summary report.
 - Supplemental budget impact model information (if applicable).



The 15 teams with the highest scores will advance to the Semi-Finals phase. Semi-Finalist teams will be announced in a special P&T Competition newsletter no later than Monday, February 12.

Semi-Finalist teams must share the following assignments no later than 11:59 pm EDT on Wednesday, February 21, 2024:

- PowerPoint file for a P&T Committee presentation (not to exceed 15 minutes) that succinctly conveys and supports the findings and recommendations in the drug monograph
- A narrated recording (voices only) of the P&T Committee presentation.



The five teams with the highest scores in the Semi-Finals phase will be invited to compete in the P&T Competition Finals. The Finals phase culminates in a live session held in conjunction with the AMCP 2024 Annual Meeting in New Orleans, April 16 to 19. Finalist teams will be announced in a special P&T Competition newsletter no later than Friday, March 8.

During the live P&T Competition Finals session, teams will make their P&T Committee presentation to a panel of judges and respond to questions. These judges also will review and score each team's drug monograph and PowerPoint slides before the live session.

The top teams will be determined based on the combined scores for drug monograph, PowerPoint slides, and P&T Committee presentation.
