INTERNSHIP REQUIREMENTS

- Currently enrolled as a full-time
 Doctor of Pharmacy degree student
 in an ACPE-accredited school or
 college of pharmacy with anticipated
 graduation in 2021 or 2022.
- Candidates must submit an online application, two letters of recommendation and a letter of good academic standing from their institution including cumulative GPA.
- Must be eligible for employment in the U.S.

2020 INTERNSHIP OVERVIEW

This internship stimulates student pharmacists' interest in career options in health outcomes and pharmacoeconomics through exposure to research, measurement and applications to evidence-based decision-making. In addition, the interns will gain knowledge of the pharmaceutical industry and managed health care systems, plus complete a rotation at AMCP/ Foundation HQ.

Interns, through their work with the Allergan Global Health Economics and Outcomes Research Department, will gain exposure to:

- The importance of health outcomes in the development and marketing of a pharmaceutical product
- The process of drug discovery
- The process of drug development through the various phases of clinical trials
- Economic, clinical and humanistic outcomes-measurement techniques
- AMCP Format-based product dossier development and its use in the formulary decision-making process.
